

It has been said that paragons do not exist; if that is true, why then do we fall in love with a perfect stranger?...

The prelude to the first verse and vocals is to be composed fitting to a sensuous balad, during which in coinsidence can be prominently heard the lead vocalist fitfully muttering the words "Shou-shou baby" as if he were rousing restlessly from a dream or nightmare, culminating to his abrupt awakening (\* female vocal "I had the radio on") calling out frantically "Shou-shou baby!" followed by a deep sigh of disappointment.

Dear Listener,

If you're left a little puzzled after listening to Shou-Shou Baby, I'll explain. Well, Very Subtly the song is an off-beat epitaph to Marilyn Monroe - But! During the compositional stages of Shou-Shou Baby by design I was discrete in my choice of wording. I didn't want people to say "Oh No, not ANOTHER post-humos tribulation to Marilyn Monroe". For instance, if I had written such a verse as: "Oh Norma Jean, Perfection - Personifier". That single phrase would have disclosed the whole mystique and fed the listener's curiousty. In Shou-Shou Baby I wanted to create just enough clues to provoke one's thought.

The hysterics at the end of the song are my representation — in true Prince Style — the points where she killed herself and I imagine who ever she was talking to on the telephone the night she committed suicide, must have been frantically trying to talk her out of doing it. (FACT: WHEN MARILYN MONROE'S SUICIDE WAS DISCOVERED, HER BODY WAS FOUND FACE DOWN ON HER BED, CLUTCHED IN HER HAND WAS THE BEDROOM'S TELEPHONE RECIEVER).

When you have time, have a look at Page 220, Section 3 of the Collins Mini Gem Dictionary of Quotations. I go to great extents to research my subjects, which involves a lot of legwork and careful planning before I write and in Shou-Shou Baby's case, a 'Difficult' Song.


